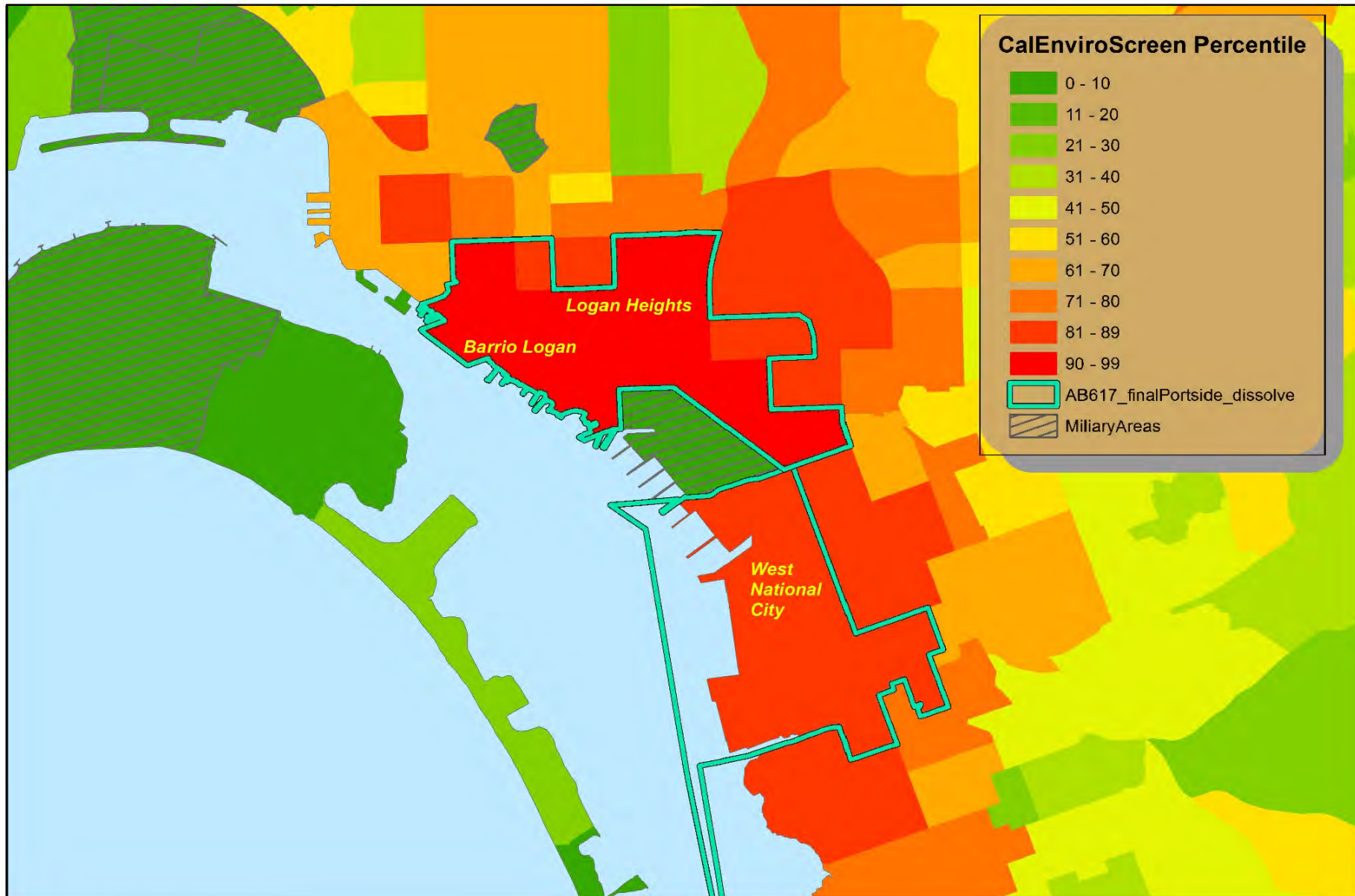

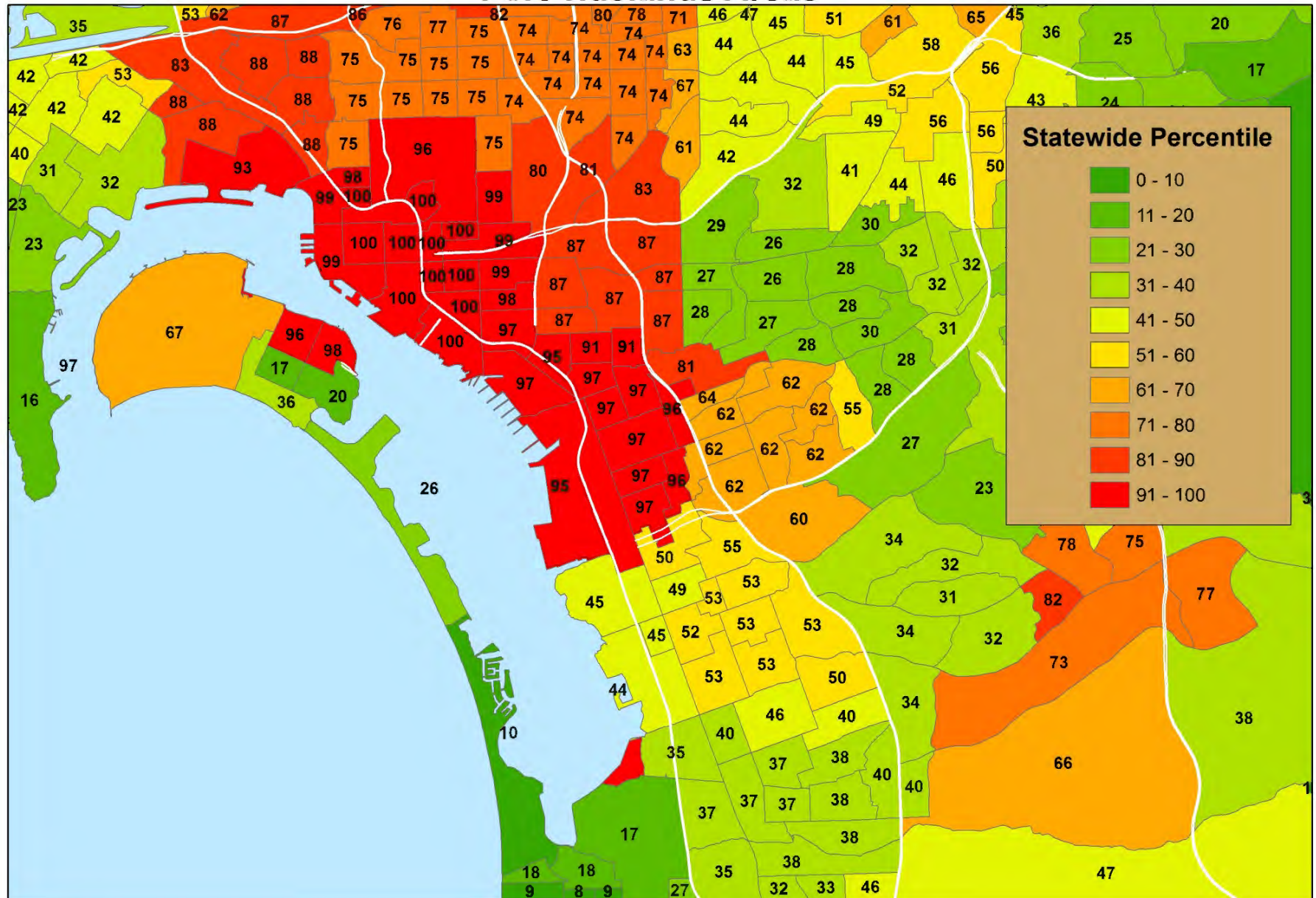

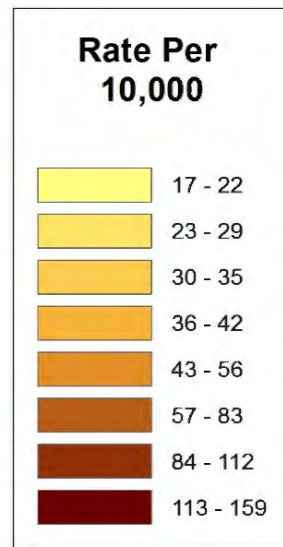
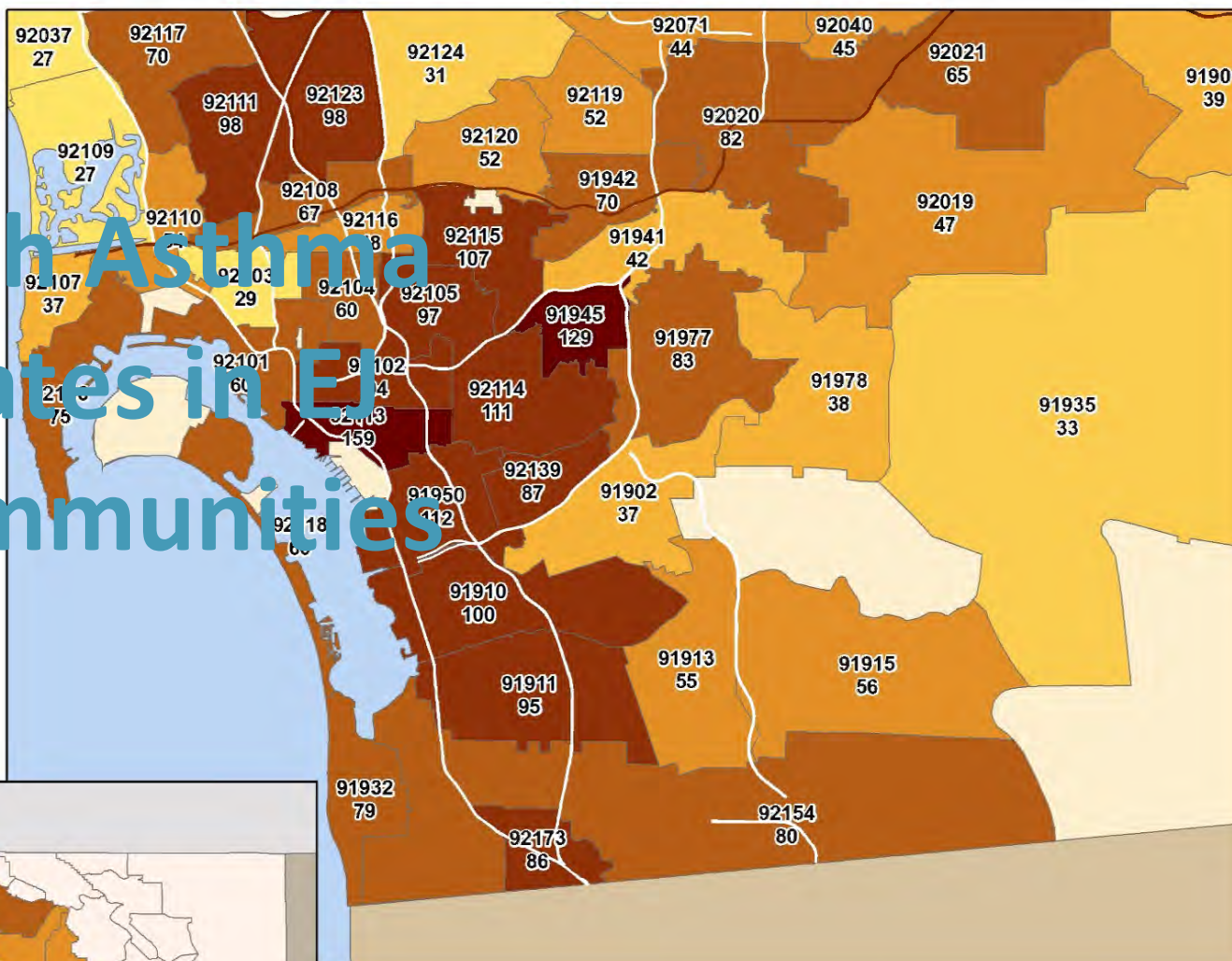

2015 Children's Asthma ER Rates by Zipcode, Rate per 10,000, Zipcodes with More than 5 Only

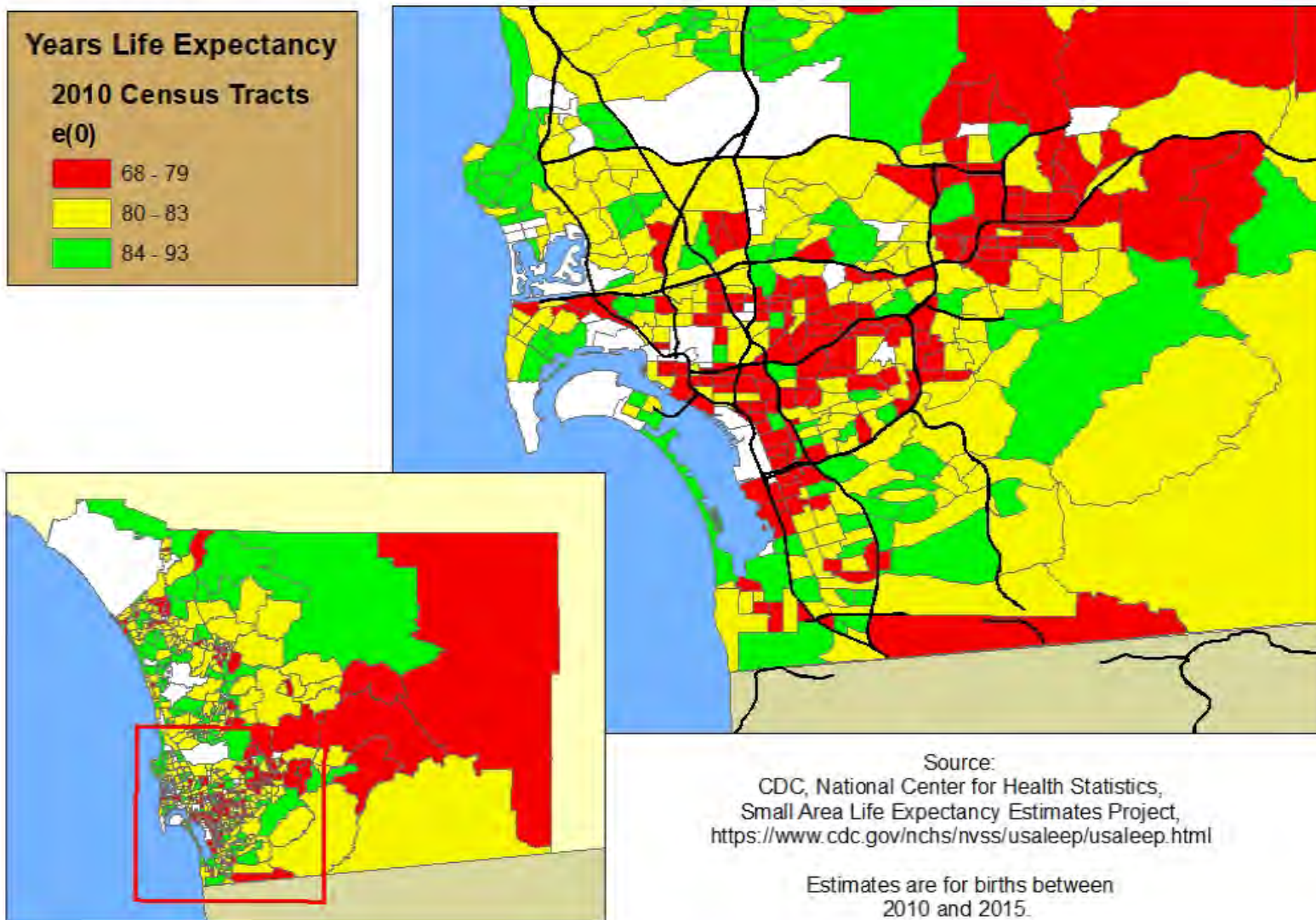
High Asthma

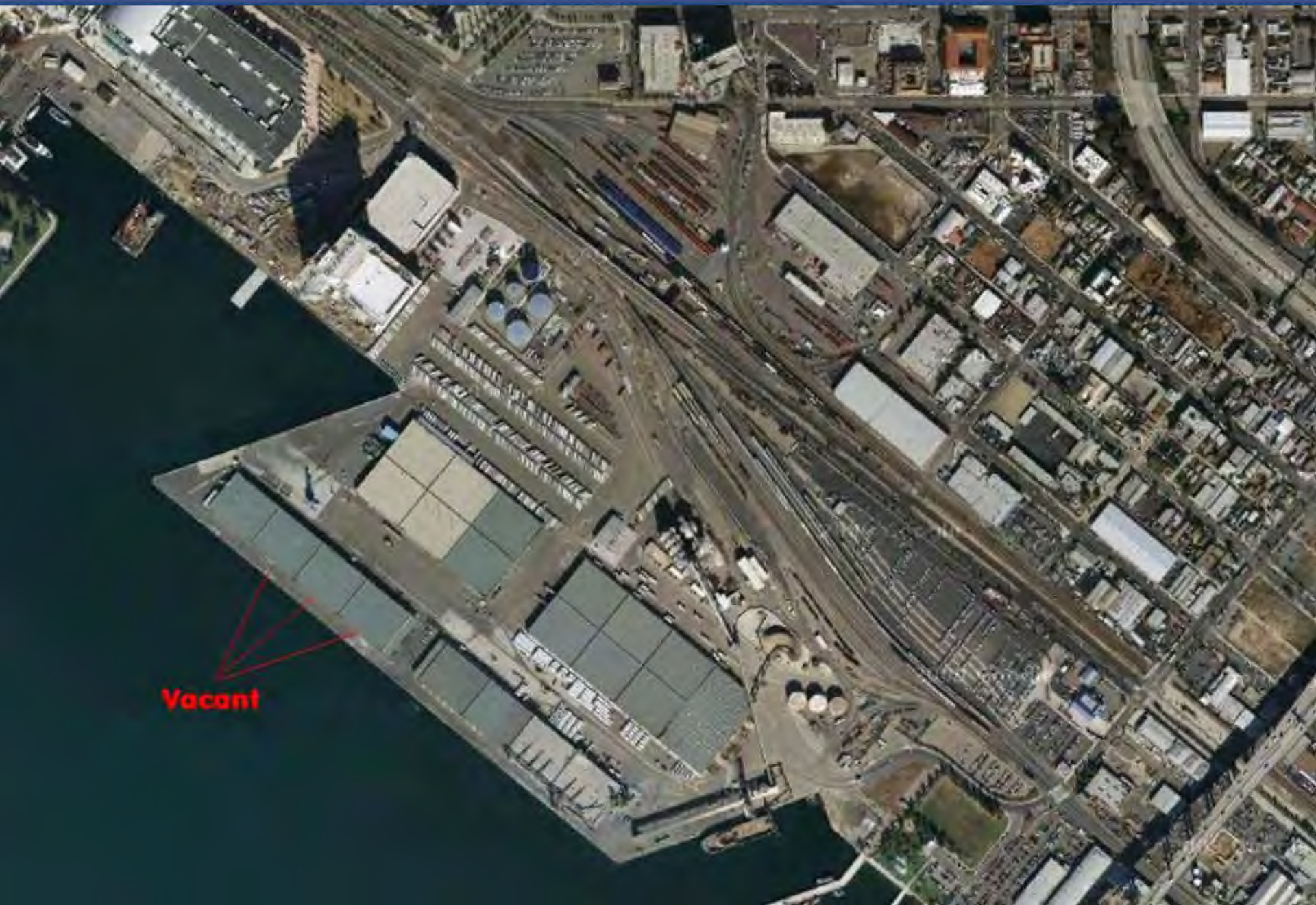

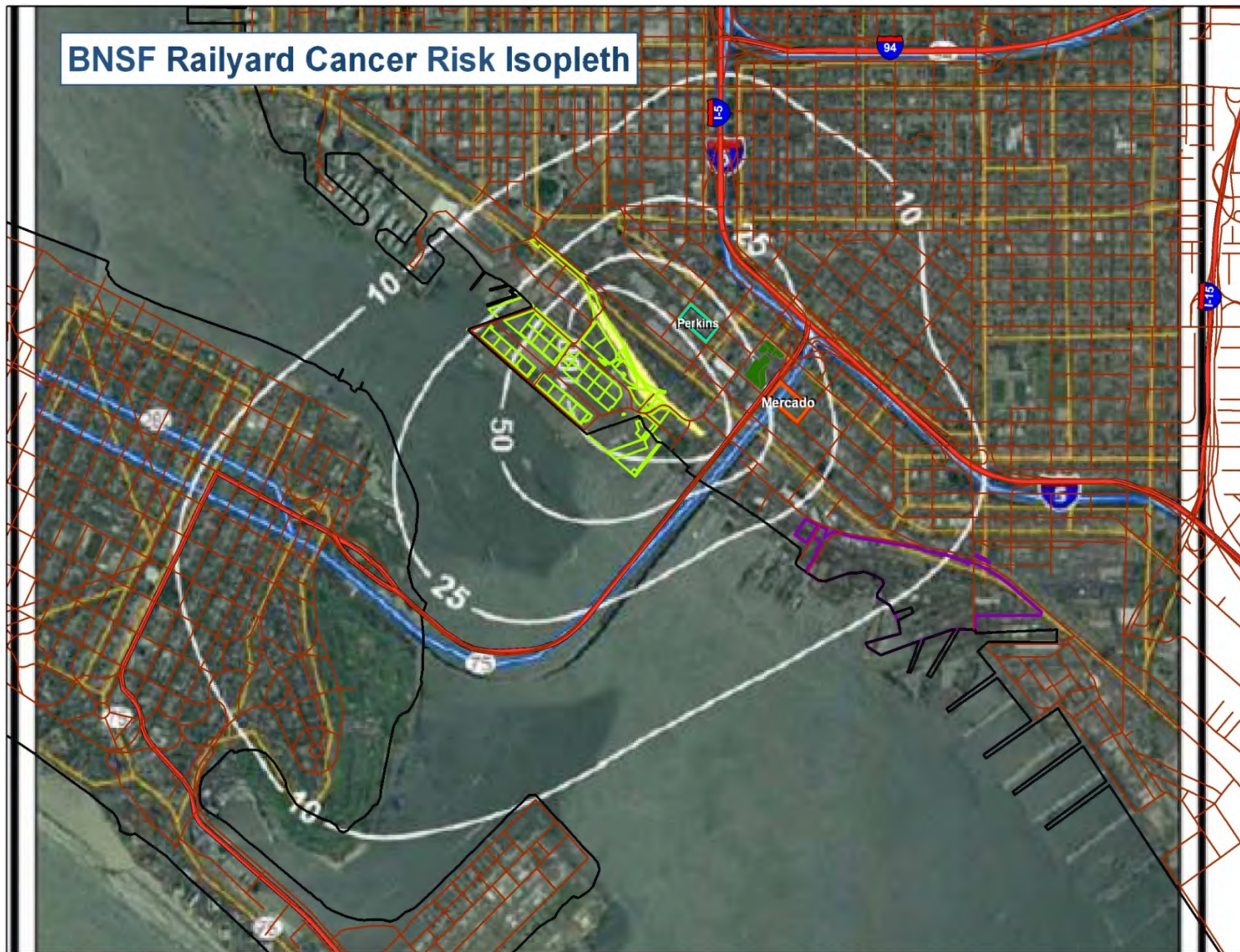

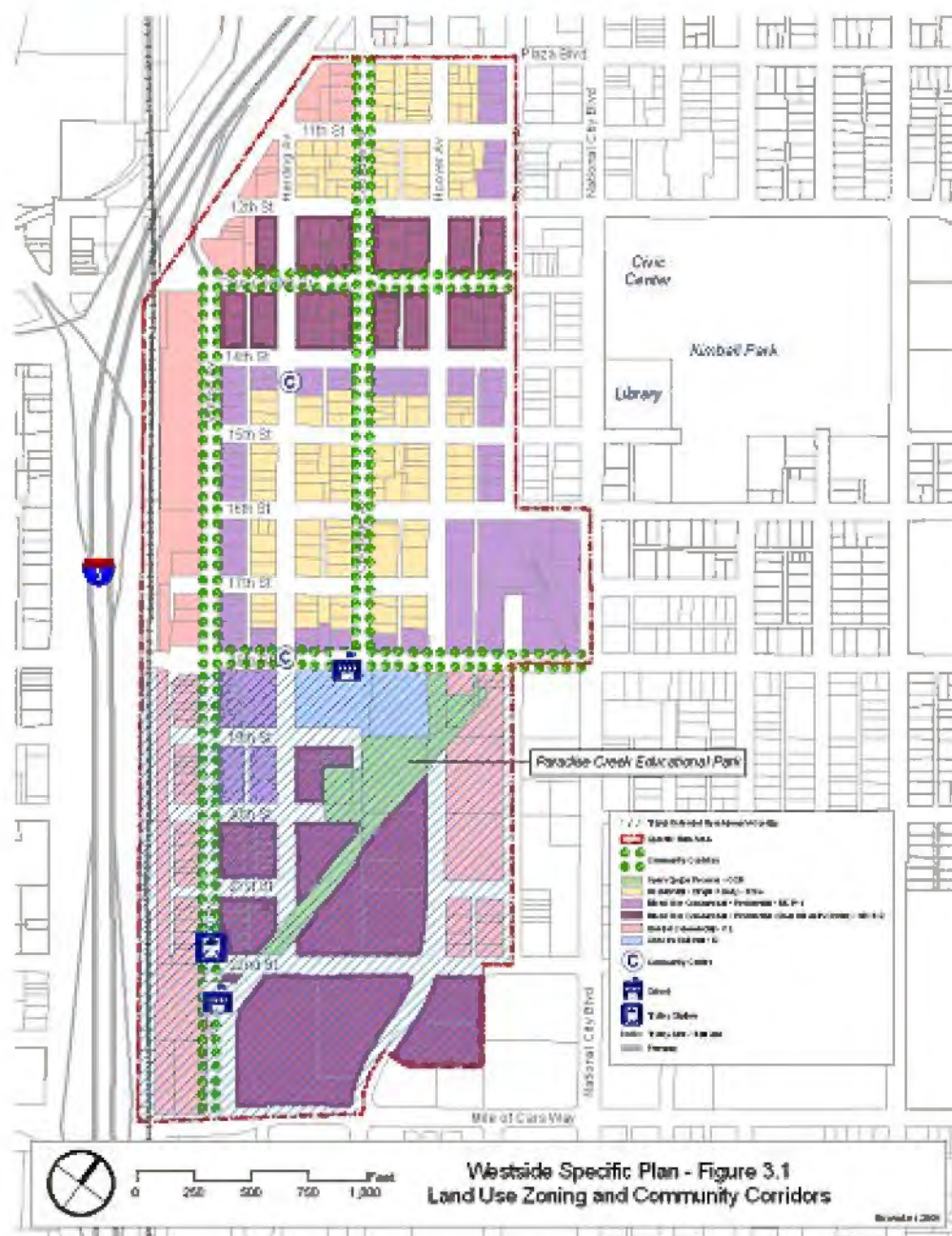

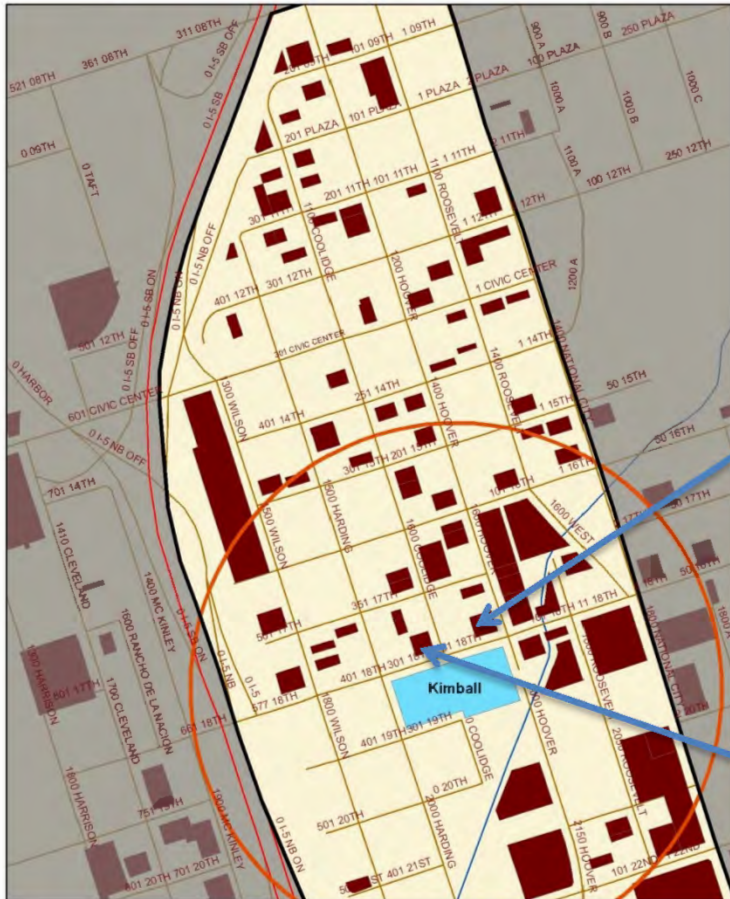

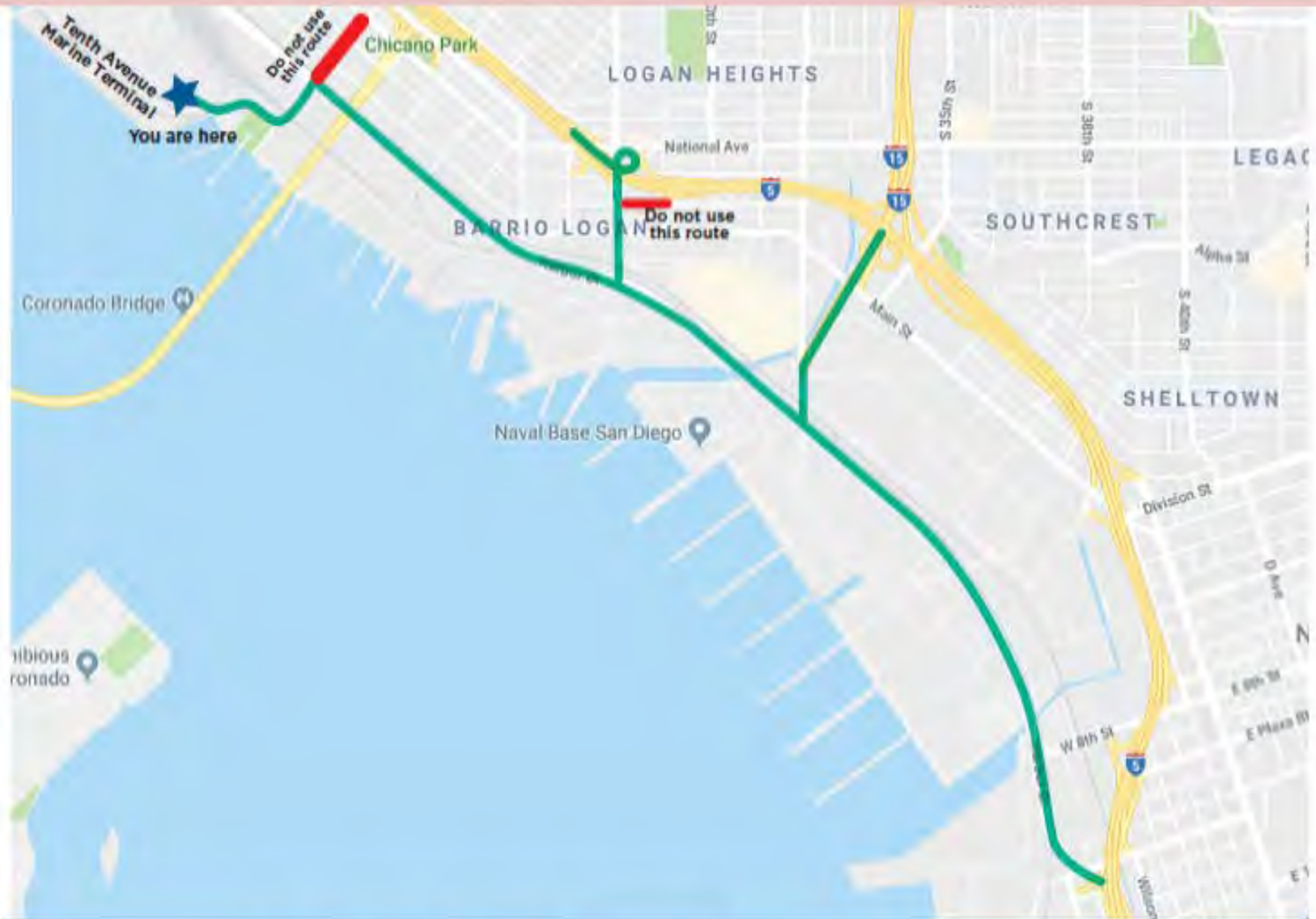
Red circle indicates the area within 1000 feet of Kimball Elementary School.

EMISSION REDUCTIONS

- **Port sources:** ships, harbor craft, cargo handling equipment, TRUs, trucks, rail
- **Shipyards & Navy:** diesel, metals, solvents,
- **Smaller industries:** TACs, diesel
- **Autobody shops:** fuels, paints, diisocyanates
- **High accident potentials:** recyclers, autobody shops, compressed gas & chemical storage
- **Roadways:** traffic pollutants
